I can sing over 20 songs from memory from this school year! I use a soft singing voice and match most of the pitches correctly without help. I have also sung a solo or duet in class so that I can practice sharing my beautiful voice with others. Ask me to sing my favorite song for you!	
I can keep a steady beat with my hands and feet while listening to recorded music and while singing with the class. I can also use scarves, parachutes, and <i>Mr. Stretchy</i> to show directional movement (up, down, in, out).
